

Storyboarding Volunteer Opportunity

Thank you for volunteering to support the Worldwide Orphans Foundation (WWO) signature program called Element of Play®(EOP). The goal of EOP is to provide underserved, young children living through the traumas of war, poverty and disaster, evidence-based and fun ways to reach the developmental milestones of listening, language, and social skills through play. Our volunteers craft and assemble the storyboard play kits for our young children in Bulgaria, Ethiopia, Haiti, Ukraine, Vietnam, and the Bronx.

These kits are used in various ways:

- At the preschool level when children are split up into small groups to follow along while the teacher reads the story, they add the pieces on their group felt
- In a large group to ask reading comprehension questions
- At home to use with siblings and parents

Supplies to purchase:

- The children's book that goes with the character pieces (Brown Bear Brown Bear, Three Bears
- Mary Wore Her Red Dress or The Hungry Caterpillar)
- Felt - the color that you would want to use as the background for the story and cut to approximately 14in x 18in
- Velcro - these will stick to the back of the laminated pieces and then you can use the pieces with the felt to retell the story
- Laminating sheets and a laminator
- Crayons, markers, colored pencils - whatever you want to use to color the pieces
- 1-gallon Ziplock bags or anything that will hold the story kit once you have created it - the pieces, the felt, the book

Instructions:

- Choose one of these story packets that WWO will email you and print it out
- Color the characters with crayons, markers, colored pencils - whatever you would like to use
- Laminate the page
- Cut out the pieces
